## Letter from Leadership

Dear Clients, Volunteers and Friends of Paws with Purpose,

Paws with Purpose is committed to doing what is in the best interests of our clients, staff, volunteers, supporters and the greater community in these very difficult times. We are following the recommendations of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention regarding Covid-19, as well as state and local guidelines and instructions for the safety of our community.

To ensure everyone's safety, we have adopted the following:

- Our staff and volunteers are working from home and remain available by phone, email and/or video conference to our clients and puppy trainers for any needed support, including inquiries about applying for an assistance dog.
- We are following the recommendations of Assistance Dogs International, in line with public health officials, for continuing to train our dogs and follow up with working teams.
- Regularly scheduled training classes for puppy trainers and clients are suspended until further notice, with individual support offered via phone and email.
- Our dogs in training continue to receive optimal care through our partnership with the Kentucky Correctional Institution for Women, as we adhere to the Department of Corrections' policies regarding visitation and contact.
- Our dogs continue to receive all necessary veterinary care from the excellent staff of Crestwood Animal Hospital.
- Our 5K Fun Run and Walkathon that was scheduled for April 19 has been postponed and we will announce plans for rescheduling of the event as circumstances permit.

Even as we must keep physical distance from one another, we will hold each of you close in our common commitment to our mission and to the well-being of our community.









It is with sadness that we have to say goodbye to one of our loved PWP dogs, Valerie. Valerie came to Paws with Purpose in the Fall of 2004. Her trainers, Jerry and Sharon Klopfenstein, were looking for a volunteer project at the time and saw an article in the newspaper featuring the PWP program. Jerry took Valerie with him to his practice at Louisville Behavioral Health where she obtained socialization skills so she could help the young clients who were being seen. The young clients were extremely interested in Valerie and soon began to look for her as they came into the waiting room. This unique background gave her the skills needed to become an effective and loving therapy dog. At the age of one and a half Valerie was placed at Louisville Behavioral Health as a Facility/Therapy Dog where she remained on assignment until Jerry's retirement in 2009. She not only helped with therapy; she was a morale booster for staff as well. Valerie's career continued with visits to Rehab Centers, school reading programs, and assisting in PWP presentations. Valerie gave the students confidence and a sense of pride. Valerie continued these activities until she was retired from her duties in 2014. The love and devotion she gave to Jerry and Sharon along with all the students she helped will never be forgotten.



It is with great sadness that ADI announces the passing of Sister Pauline Quinn. She was a pioneer for the industry and the human-animal bond, especially for the underserved population. She founded one of our accredited member programs, Prison Pet Partnership in Washington state. Her impact was great in the assistance dog industry and we are forever blessed by her dedication and compassion.

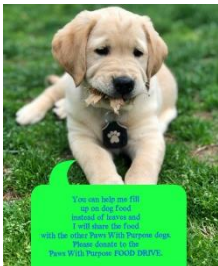
